

Pacific Comox Resources Ltd. files Annual Materials for the period ended October 31, 2011

Toronto, Ontario--(Newsfile Corp. - March 14, 2012) - Pacific Comox Resources Ltd. (TSX-V:PCM) reports that effective March 8, 2012, the TSX Venture Exchange suspended trading in the Company's securities as a result of a Cease Trade Order (CTO) issued on March 8, 2012 by the British Columbia Securities Commission because the Company had not filed its Financial Statements or the Management Discussion and Analysis for the period ended October 31, 2011.

The Company filed the required documents on March 14, 2012.

Pacific Comox is now working to have the CTO revoked and trading reinstated. Reinstatement to trading can only occur when the CTO is revoked and the Exchange has concluded its reinstatement review.
